Dear Parent/Carer

Our students are amongst the smartest in the city and I am very proud of their appearance. Students are aware they must be in full uniform each day. As well as in school, they are expected to wear their uniform correctly to and from school. A full uniform list is detailed below and I would be grateful if you could spend time checking this to ensure your son/daughter arrives properly dressed and groomed.

Boys

- Black shoes
- Plain black or white ankle socks
- Plain black trousers
- White shirt with stiff collar (long or short sleeved)
- Maroon sweater with school logo (recommended)
- Black blazer with school badge
- School tie: KS3 maroon + white stripes
KS4 plain maroon



Girls

- Black shoes
- Plain black or white ankle socks
- Plain black tights
- Plain black skirt which **must** be worn to the **knee** or plain black **tailored** trousers
- White shirt with stiff collar (long & short sleeved)
- Maroon sweater with school logo (recommended)
- Black blazer with school badge
- School tie: KS3 maroon + white stripes
KS4 plain maroon



Please note the following items are **not** to be worn at school:

- Trainers
- Hoodies
- Leggings
- Jeggings
- Inappropriately short skirts
- Plimsolls
- Boots

On the grounds of health & safety, students must **not** wear any other jewellery, except for a watch. However, students who have pierced ears may wear **one** small stud (no sleepers) in each ear, but **these must be removed for all PE lessons**. **NO** other body piercings or earrings designed to stretch the ear lobe are allowed. Should students wear any other jewellery this will be confiscated and placed in the school safe until the end of term.



Students are expected to wear the uniform correctly which includes top buttons being done up, ties correctly tied, shirts tucked in and for girls, skirts of the correct length. Could you please ensure your son/daughter respects the uniform by wearing it appropriately at all times. There are some girls who have clearly 'outgrown' their skirts. They must reach the top of their knees – if this is not the case, a new skirt will need to be purchased. Black schools shoes must be worn at all times. Trainers and plimsolls must **not** be worn. Make-up and nail varnish is **not** to be worn by any student in school. Students will be required to remove make-up and nail varnish.

There will be a **whole school uniform check on Monday 9th May**. Any student not meeting the uniform requirements will be asked to have the correct uniform by the next day. On Tuesday the 10th May parents will be contacted if their child fails to have the correct uniform and these students will be sent straight home to change into the correct uniform and return to school.
