Purpose

The purpose of this evening is to:

- Introduce myself as the Director of Learning for Year 7.
- To inform parents how students have settled in.
- Provide parents with relevant information regarding this academic year.

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Attendance Matters

All students are expected to be on site by 8.25am at the very latest and be ready to start registration at 8.30am

PERSISTENT LATENESS

If a student is late three times for registration during one term, without a valid reason, then a late detention will be issued. A detention for each subsequent late during that term, will also be issued.

When required an attendance report for initially one week will be issued. This may also be issued if a student is persistently late to lessons.

Saturday morning detention and other more serious sanctions may be applied for persistent offenders.

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Rewards

- 97% and above will result in your name being put into an end of year draw for the grand prize. (prize to be decided)
- Tutor group trophies for best attendance over a fortnight
- Certificates issued for attendance at 95% and above at the end of each term.

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Uniform

Students should look smart, clean and tidy at all times.

Shirts must be tucked in at all times with top button done up.

Hair must be a natural colour and no extreme hair styles are acceptable.

Make-up and nail varnish is **not** to be worn by any student in school.

Students will be required to remove make-up and nail varnish.

On the grounds of health & safety, students must **not** wear any other jewellery, except for a watch. However, students who have pierced ears may wear **one** small stud (no sleepers) in each ear, but **these must be removed for all PE lessons. NO** other body piercings or earrings designed to stretch the ear lobe are allowed. Should students wear jewellery this will be confiscated and placed in the school safe until the end of term.

Tie and Blazer must be worn on site

NB: HOODIES/RETRO-STYLE SPORTS JACKETS, TRAINERS, PLIMSOLLS AND BOOTS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL BE CONFISCATED IF WORN

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Consequences for incorrect uniform and lack of equipment

Strikes will be issued by members of staff

3 strikes will result in a 1 hour detention

Failure to attend detention will be a Friday 1 hour 30 minutes detention

Failure to attend Friday detention will result in a Saturday morning detention (8.00am – 10am)

Failure to attend Saturday morning detention could result in isolation until parents are able to attend a meeting and the Saturday detention is re-done

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Homework

In Year 7 subjects set regular relevant Homework including reading.

Subjects put the homework on Show My Homework (see booklet for clarification)

This enables students to check homework recorded in their planner and helps parents keep up to date and fully informed as often additional support and/or resources are added to the site.

Homework should be completed to a high standard and presented in line with school policy.
