Dear Parents/Carers

Our uniform is designed to make life straightforward for our students and to allow them to work easily and safely so that they can make learning their priority. We know that a high standard of uniform has a positive impact on behaviour in school and on making a calm, purposeful working environment for all students. When students are dressed in the correct school uniform, they are positive role models for their peers and present a positive and impressive image of the school in the local community.

Parents and students sign an agreement in Year 7 that sets out their commitment to follow the uniform code. We thank the majority of parents and students who do support the school and accept the uniform code. We ask that all parents show their support by insisting that their children wear the correct uniform to school.

Jewellery

May I also take this opportunity to remind parents specifically about jewellery. We have very few problems with inappropriate jewellery during the year but there are sometimes issues with new piercings at the start or during the school year. I would like to take this opportunity to remind all parents/carers that the school policy is for students to only wear one stud per ear and that all other piercings are not allowed in school. If your son/daughter has any other piercings please can you ensure that these are removed after the Easter break. If your son/daughter arrives to school next term with these piercings in the first instance they will be asked to remove them and hand them to the member of staff and these will then be stored safely in the schools safe. If your son/daughter refuses to take them out or hand them over they will be sent home and asked to come back to school once they have removed the piercings.

We will continue to enforce our uniform rules and students who do not wear correct uniform should expect to be sanctioned. We keep a stock of key uniform items and if a student arrives with incorrect uniform, they may be told to change the offending items for correct clothing which will be loaned to them.
