In order for your child to reach their full potential in Maths, little and often is the best strategy. At this stage, I would suggest doing 30 minutes of Maths 4 to 5 times a week.

Each student in Year 10 has completed an exam analysis sheet and they need to use this in order to develop the areas they have difficulties in.
