LEARN TO LIVE HERTFORDSHIRE


The Learn to Live programme is aimed at Post 16 students to inform, influence and educate young drivers, allowing them to make informed decisions about driving safely.

Learn to Live is a multi-agency programme run by the Hertfordshire County Council's Road Safety Unit and incorporates Hertfordshire's Emergency Services, Driving Standards Agency, Trading Standards and Hertfordshire Highways amongst others. It is a one-and-a-half-hour presentation designed to appeal to young adults.

This is a highly informative programme that has the potential to save young peoples' lives and, therefore, a valuable and compulsory presentation for all students to attend. We will assume your son/daughter will attend unless you inform us otherwise.
